- **DUES ARE INCREASED TO \$10.00/YEAR.** A ballot was handed out to all dues paying Alumni at the banquet on May 24th to raise dues and the returned ballots were overwhelmingly in favor of raising the dues. The vote was 55 yes, 2 no.
- 185 ATTENDED THE 2014 BANQUET. We had 172 Alumni spanning 75 years! There were also 13 out of 15 seniors at our banquet! Best percentage in many years. Comments: Approval rating--98% - 65% excellent, 33% satisfactory, 2% poor. Negative comments centered around organization of food, waiting in line, not enough food, and the scholarship cans were annoying. Great feedback about the auction; they want more!

In the 1960's, while editor of *The Waitsburg Times*, Tom served as a resource to the WHS journalism classes and was always willing to help when asked. He also took pictures of the Alumni Reunion classes for many years.

Anita taught third grade at Waitsburg Elementary School and saw hundreds of her students graduate from WHS. She also assisted Tom as he published *The Times*.
