Message from WHS Current ASB President—

Our officers for this current 2016-17 school year are: Jacob Dunn, President, Vice President, Taylor Hays, Secretary, Kelsey Alleman, and Treasurer, Loren Negron. Mrs. Roseann Groom is the Advisor.

Officers and class representatives identified several goals for our year in August, and have been carrying them out through assemblies. One of our main goals is to involve all students in some way throughout the year.

Football Combine With Dayton

In the early spring of 2016, Waitsburg and Dayton began talking about combining their football teams so both schools could continue to play 11-man football. Both communities met with stakeholders individually, and both school boards joined together with administrators, athletic directors, coaches, students and communities to better understand how the combination might work.

Both school boards approved the Combine, with Troy Larsen, WHS Alumni, as head coach. The team began spring practices shortly before the school year ended, and at the end of the Football Season, the team had a record of: 10-2. According to *The Times*, "DW finished their season with a 10-2 record. The team won the Eastern Washington Athletic Conference championship, going undefeated in conference play. DW also won their first two playoff games, against Tonasket and Tri-Cities Prep. Not only did DW win the title in the

conference's first year of existence, but also it was the first year of the Dayton-Waitsburg combine. The success of the combine has led the Dayton and Waitsburg schools to explore working together in other sports. The schools have approved a baseball combine and wrestling co-op." (Nov. 24, 2016)



This 4-year commitment is off to a great beginning, and has allowed both schools to work together to make sure that all student athletes have a chance to participate in any sport (wrestling and cross country, for example) that one or the other school is not able to offer. Another great feature of the Combine was a chance for both cheer teams to work together, under the direction of Kristine Warren, Advisor from Dayton. When visiting with students, parents, and community members throughout the season, the comments were very positive.

First Karen Huwe Mohney Service Award (2015) goes to 1964 Alumni, Jeff Broom

The Alumni Association Board established a service award to honor graduates who have gone above and beyond to help others, just as Alumnus Karen Mohney (who passed away in 2014 had done).

Jeff, a retired mechanical engineer, and his wife Gayle, moved back to Waitsburg in the 1990's. He continued to consult on various construction sites around the country for another 5 or 6 years. Jeff has served on the City Council, has been president of the Waitsburg Historical Society, and helped establish the WHS Alumni Scholarship fund as an Alumni Board Member. Jeff served on the United Way of Walla Walla County, and the WWCC Foundation Board of Governors. He is a Lion's Club member, and has spent hundreds of hours making Waitsburg a better place in which to live.

Margie Gagnon Benson Honored at the 2016 Banquet

Margie (Class of 1966), received the second annual Karen Huwe Mohney Service Award, established by the WHS Alumni Association. Margie retired from the WSD district several years ago and has continued to coordinate the setting up and taking down of the Multipurpose Room after retirement, as well as serving on the Alumni Board. She has taken on the "Brick Project," so alumni can continue to purchase brick markers located near the entrance to the High School Gym.

Margie also serves on the Waitsburg Resource Center Board, volunteering hundreds of hours each year. In addition, she volunteers for the Frenchtown Historical Society, located in Touchet.


